



Strong Passwords

- Your passwords should be complex and difficult to guess. Ideally they should be at least 10 characters long and should have numbers, capital letters, small letters, and special characters e.g: G@teway0f!1ndiA
- Do NOT use your passwords at public computers as these may be infected with key loggers, Trojans and other malware and your password could get stolen.
- It may be a good idea to write your passwords on a piece of paper.
- Do NOT share your passwords with anyone.
- Do NOT email your passwords to anyone.
- Do NOT respond to an email asking for your password.
- If you have more than one Internet Banking account, use different passwords for each of these accounts.
- Do NOT keep the same passwords for all your accounts. i.e. Bank account, Social Media accounts, email accounts etc.
